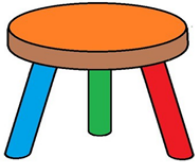




Learning Commitment



Three Legs of Responsibility at UCA: K-6 Student / Learning Coach / School

K-6 Student:

- Dedicates 25-30 hours a week to school related tasks.
 - Completes a minimum of 4-5 lessons a day, as outlined in planner.
 - Attends Live Lessons, as outlined in planner.
 - Is on camera and uses a microphone to communicate when appropriate.
 - Gets help from Learning Coach & Teacher(s)
 - Maintains consistent contact with their Homeroom Teacher.
 - Checks planner, teacher message board and/or teacher website daily.
 - Maintains a quiet place to work and study.
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K-6 Learning Coach (LC):

- Provides oversight and assists their Elementary students for 4-5 hours each day.
 - Sets a schedule (with breaks) for the student & ensures a quiet place to work.
 - Ensures that their student attends each LiveLessons on their planner, daily.
 - Monitors the student's progress/grades weekly.
 - Enters attendance daily.
 - Participates in the monthly contact call with the Homeroom Teacher.
 - Ensures their student attends In-and-Out or webmails teacher(s) with questions.
 - Ensures that the student participates in benchmark and state assessments.
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K-6 Teacher:

- Will be well versed in the grade level standards and will ensure that their instruction is in alignment with standards.
- Provides well planned LiveLessons and Targeted LiveLessons for students.
- Will attend In-and-Out where students and LCs can come with questions or concerns.
- Progress monitors students to ensure they are on target to pass their course(s), and are prepared for state assessments.
- Will make a monthly call to the student and LC to review student progress, attendance and mastery of material.
